

## **Wealth Transfer: Part 2 The Cyrus Anointing**

**<sup>20</sup> “ You are My battle-ax and weapons of war: For with you I will break the nation in pieces; With you I will destroy kingdoms; Jeremiah 51:20 (NKJV)**

**<sup>1</sup> Now in the first year of Cyrus king of Persia, that the word of the LORD by the mouth of Jeremiah might be fulfilled, the LORD stirred up the spirit of Cyrus king of Persia, so that he made a proclamation throughout all his kingdom, and also put it in writing, saying, <sup>2</sup> Thus says Cyrus king of Persia: All the kingdoms of the earth the LORD God of heaven has given me. And He has commanded me to build Him a house at Jerusalem which *is* in Judah.**

**Ezra 1:1-2 (NKJV)**

**<sup>3</sup> Who is among you of all His people? May his God be with him, and let him go up to Jerusalem which is in Judah, and build the house of the LORD God of Israel (He is God), which is in Jerusalem. <sup>4</sup> And whoever is left in any place where he dwells, let the men of his place help him with silver and gold, with goods and livestock, besides the freewill offerings for the house of God which is in Jerusalem. Ezra 1: 3-4 (NKJV)**

**1.) \*Cyrus the Great is known as one the greatest conquerors throughout history.**

**2.) His birth was prophetically declared by the prophet Isaiah one hundred and fifty years before he was born.**

**3.) God raised him up at a key, strategic time to liberate the Jewish captives from Babylonian bondage.**

***4.) The decree of Cyrus provided all the wealth and resources needed to rebuild the temple and the walls of Jerusalem.***

***5.) The wealth was transferred to God's people from the Babylonian treasuries.***

***6.) The Cyrus decree set a process in motion that revolutionized a people, a governmental system and nations of the earth.***

**<sup>24</sup> Thus says the LORD, your Redeemer, And He who formed you from the womb: “ I am the LORD, who makes all things, Who stretches out the heavens all alone, Who spreads abroad the earth by Myself; <sup>25</sup> Who frustrates the signs**

**of the babblers, And drives diviners mad; Who turns wise men backward, And makes their knowledge foolishness; Isaiah 44: 24-25 (NKJV)**

**<sup>26</sup> Who confirms the word of His servant, And performs the counsel of His messengers; Who says to Jerusalem, 'You shall be inhabited,' To the cities of Judah, 'You shall be built,' And I will raise up her waste places; <sup>27</sup> Who says to the deep, 'Be dry! And I will dry up your rivers'; Isaiah 44: 26-27 (NKJV)**

**<sup>28</sup> Who says of Cyrus, 'He is My shepherd, And he shall perform all My pleasure, Saying to Jerusalem, "You shall be built," And to the temple, "Your foundation shall be laid." Isaiah 44: 28 (NKJV)**

**<sup>19</sup> Now, therefore, you are no longer strangers and foreigners, but fellow citizens with the saints and members of the household of God, <sup>20</sup> having been built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Jesus Christ Himself being the chief cornerstone. Ephesians 2:19-20 (NKJV)**

**<sup>8</sup> For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, <sup>9</sup> not of works, lest anyone should boast. <sup>10</sup> For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them. Ephesians 2:8-10 (NKJV)**

**<sup>1</sup> "Thus says the LORD to His anointed, To Cyrus, whose right hand I have held— To subdue nations before him And loose the armor of kings, To open before him the double doors, So that the gates will not be shut: <sup>2</sup> ' I will go before you And make the crooked places straight; I will break in pieces the gates of bronze And cut the bars of iron. Isaiah 45: 1-2 (NKJV)**

**<sup>3</sup> I will give you the treasures of darkness And hidden riches of secret places, That you may know that I, the LORD, Who call you by your name, Am the God of Israel. <sup>4</sup> For Jacob My servant's sake, And Israel My elect, I have even called you by your name; I have named you, though you have not known Me.**

**Isaiah 45: 3-4 (NKJV)**

**<sup>10</sup> to the intent that now the manifold wisdom of God might be made known by the church to the principalities and powers in the heavenly places, <sup>11</sup>according to the eternal purpose which He accomplished in Christ Jesus our Lord,**

**12 in whom we have boldness and access with confidence through faith in Him.  
13 Therefore I ask that you do not lose heart at my tribulations for you, which is your glory. Ephesians 3: 10-13 (NKJV)**

**20 Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us, Ephesians 3:20 (NKJV)**

**28 Who says of Cyrus, 'He is My shepherd, And he shall perform all My pleasure, Saying to Jerusalem, "You shall be built," And to the temple, "Your foundation shall be laid." Isaiah 44: 28 (NKJV)**

**11 Therefore remember that you, once Gentiles in the flesh—who are called Uncircumcision by what is called the Circumcision made in the flesh by hands— Ephesians 2: 11 (NKJV)**

**11 " On that day I will raise up The tabernacle of David, which has fallen down, And repair its damages; I will raise up its ruins, And rebuild it as in the days of old; 12 That they may possess the remnant of Edom, And all the Gentiles who are called by My name," Says the LORD who does this thing. Amos 9: 11-12 (NKJV)**

**1 Arise, shine; For your light has come! And the glory of the LORD is risen upon you. 2 For behold, the darkness shall cover the earth, And deep darkness the people; But the LORD will arise over you, And His glory will be seen upon you. 3 The Gentiles shall come to your light, And kings to the brightness of your rising. Isaiah 60: 1-3 (NKJV)**

**4 " Lift up your eyes all around, and see: They all gather together, they come to you; Your sons shall come from afar, And your daughters shall be nursed at your side. 5 Then you shall see and become radiant, And your heart shall swell with joy; Because the abundance of the sea shall be turned to you, The wealth of the Gentiles shall come to you. Isaiah 60: 4-5 (NKJV)**

**6 The multitude of camels shall cover your land, The dromedaries of Midian and Ephah; All those from Sheba shall come; They shall bring gold and incense, And they shall proclaim the praises of the LORD. Isaiah 60: 6 (NKJV)**

**8 “ Who are these who fly like a cloud, And like doves to their roosts? 9 Surely the coastlands shall wait for Me; And the ships of Tarshish will come first, To bring your sons from afar, Their silver and their gold with them, To the name of the LORD your God, And to the Holy One of Israel, Because He has glorified you. 10 “ The sons of foreigners shall build up your walls, And their kings shall minister to you; For in My wrath I struck you, But in My favor I have had mercy on you. Isaiah 60: 8-10 (NKJV)**

**11 Therefore your gates shall be open continually; They shall not be shut day or night, That men may bring to you the wealth of the Gentiles, And their kings in procession. 12 For the nation and kingdom which will not serve you shall perish, And those nations shall be utterly ruined. 13 “ The glory of Lebanon shall come to you, The cypress, the pine, and the box tree together, To beautify the place of My sanctuary; And I will make the place of My feet glorious.**

**Isaiah 60: 11-13 (NKJV)**

**14 Also the sons of those who afflicted you Shall come bowing to you, And all those who despised you shall fall prostrate at the soles of your feet; And they shall call you The City of the LORD, Zion of the Holy One of Israel. 15 “ Whereas you have been forsaken and hated, So that no one went through you, I will make you an eternal excellence, A joy of many generations. Isaiah 60: 14-15 (NKJV)**

**16 You shall drink the milk of the Gentiles, And milk the breast of kings; You shall know that I, the LORD, am your Savior And your Redeemer, the Mighty One of Jacob. 17 “ Instead of bronze I will bring gold, Instead of iron I will bring silver, Instead of wood, bronze, And instead of stones, iron. I will also make your officers peace, And your magistrates righteousness. 18 Violence shall no longer be heard in your land, Neither wasting nor destruction within your borders; But you shall call your walls Salvation, And your gates Praise.**
