Candle 1/The Solider Candle:

<sup>3</sup> Then God said, "Let there be light"; and there was light. <sup>4</sup> And God saw the light, that it was good; and God divided the light from the darkness. <sup>5</sup> God called the light Day, and the darkness He called Night. So the evening and the morning were the first day.  
Genesis 1:3-5 (NKJV)

<sup>16</sup> "I, Jesus, have sent My angel to testify to you these things in the churches. I am the Root and the Offspring of David, the Bright and Morning Star."  
Revelation 22:16 (NKJV)

Candle 2:

<sup>15</sup> and let them be for lights in the firmament of the heavens to give light on the earth"; and it was so.  
Genesis 1:15 (NKJV)

<sup>14</sup> "You are the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hidden. <sup>15</sup> Nor do they light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a lampstand, and it gives light to all who are in the house. <sup>16</sup> Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.  
Matthew 5:14-16 (NKJV)

Candle 3:

<sup>16</sup> Then God made two great lights: the greater light to rule the day, and the lesser light to rule the night. He made the stars also. <sup>17</sup> God set them in the firmament of the heavens to give light on the earth, <sup>18</sup> and to rule over the day and over the night, and to divide the light from the darkness. And God saw that it was good.  
Genesis 1:16-18 (NKJV)

<sup>22</sup> "The lamp of the body is the eye. If therefore your eye is good, your whole body will be full of light. <sup>23</sup> But if your eye is bad, your whole body will be full of darkness. If therefore the light that is in you is darkness, how great is that darkness!  
Matthew 6:22-23 (NKJV)

Candle 4:

<sup>21</sup> And the LORD went before them by day in a pillar of cloud to lead the way, and by night in a pillar of fire to give them light, so as to go by day and night.  
Exodus 13:21 (NKJV)

<sup>24</sup> "No one can serve two masters; for either he will hate the one and love the other, or else he will be loyal to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and mammon. <sup>25</sup> "Therefore I say to you, do not worry about your life, what you will eat or what you will drink; nor about your body, what

you will put on. Is not life more than food and the body more than clothing?  
Matthew 6:24-25 (NKJV)

Candle 5:

<sup>6</sup> oil for the light, and spices for the anointing oil and for the sweet incense;  
Exodus 25:6 (NKJV)

<sup>1</sup> “Then the kingdom of heaven shall be likened to ten virgins who took their lamps and went out to meet the bridegroom. <sup>2</sup> Now five of them were wise, and five were foolish. <sup>3</sup> Those who were foolish took their lamps and took no oil with them, <sup>4</sup> but the wise took oil in their vessels with their lamps.  
Matthew 25:1-4 (NKJV)

Candle 6:

<sup>37</sup> You shall make seven lamps for it, and they shall arrange its lamps so that they give light in front of it.  
Exodus 25:37 (NKJV)

<sup>1</sup> Now the angel who talked with me came back and wakened me, as a man who is wakened out of his sleep. <sup>2</sup> And he said to me, “What do you see?” So I said, “I am looking, and there is a lampstand of solid gold with a bowl on top of it, and on the stand seven lamps with seven pipes to the seven lamps. <sup>3</sup> Two olive trees are by it, one at the right of the bowl and the other at its left.”  
Zechariah 4:1-3 (NKJV)

Candle 7:

<sup>20</sup> “And you shall command the children of Israel that they bring you pure oil of pressed olives for the light, to cause the lamp to burn continually.  
Exodus 27:20 (NKJV)

<sup>28</sup> For You will light my lamp;  
The LORD my God will enlighten my darkness.  
Psalm 18:28 (NKJV)

Candle 8:

<sup>16</sup> The Jews had light and gladness, joy and honor.  
Esther 8:16 (NKJV)

<sup>105</sup> Your word is a lamp to my feet  
And a light to my path.  
Psalm 119:105 (NKJV)

Candle 9:

<sup>8</sup> Then your light shall break forth like the morning, Your healing shall spring forth speedily, And your righteousness shall go before you; The glory of the LORD shall be your rear guard.  
Isaiah 58:8 (NKJV)

<sup>12</sup> Then Jesus spoke to them again, saying, "I am the light of the world. He who follows Me shall not walk in darkness, but have the light of life."  
John 8:12 (NKJV)

<sup>46</sup> I have come as a light into the world, that whoever believes in Me should not abide in darkness.  
John 12:46 (NKJV)

Closing:

<sup>8</sup> For you were once darkness, but now you are light in the Lord. Walk as children of light <sup>9</sup> (for the fruit of the Spirit is in all goodness, righteousness, and truth),  
Ephesians 5:8-9 (NKJV)
