"Get the answers to all eight and you will have a life changing experience in 2011"- says the Lord!

¹ And you He made alive, who were dead in trespasses and sins, ² in which you once walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit who now works in the sons of disobedience, ³ among whom also we all once conducted ourselves in the

lusts of our flesh, fulfilling the desires of the flesh and of the mind, and were by nature children of wrath, just as the others.⁴ But God, who is rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us,⁵ even when we were dead in trespasses, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved),⁶ and raised us up together, and made us sit together in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus,⁷ that in the ages to come He might show the exceeding riches of His grace in His kindness toward us in Christ Jesus.⁸ For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God,⁹ not of works, lest anyone should boast.¹⁰ For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them.

Ephesians 2:1-10 (*these verses are a test between the spirit and the flesh)

¹ I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service.² And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.³ For I say, through the grace given to me, to everyone who is among you, not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think, but to think soberly, as God has dealt to each one a measure of faith.⁴ For as we have many members in one body, but all the members do not have the same function,⁵ so we, being many, are one body in Christ, and individually members of one another.⁶ Having then gifts differing according to the grace that is given to us, let us use them: if prophecy, let us prophesy in proportion to our faith;⁷ or ministry, let us use it in our ministering; he who teaches, in teaching;⁸ he who exhorts, in exhortation; he who gives, with liberality; he who leads, with diligence; he who shows mercy, with cheerfulness.⁹ Let love be without hypocrisy. Abhor what is evil. Cling to what is good.¹⁰ Be kindly affectionate to one another with brotherly love, in honor giving preference to one another;¹¹ not lagging in diligence, fervent in spirit, serving the Lord;¹² rejoicing in hope, patient in tribulation, continuing steadfastly in prayer;¹³ distributing to the needs of the saints, given to hospitality.¹⁴ Bless those who persecute you; bless and do not curse.¹⁵ Rejoice with those who rejoice, and weep with those who weep.¹⁶ Be of the same mind toward one another. Do not set your mind on high things, but associate with the humble. Do not be wise in your own opinion.¹⁷ Repay no one evil for evil. Have regard for good things in the sight of all men.¹⁸ If it is possible, as much as depends on you, live peaceably with all men.¹⁹ Beloved, do not avenge yourselves, but rather give place to wrath; for it is written, "Vengeance is Mine, I will repay," says the Lord.²⁰ Therefore

“ If your enemy is hungry, feed him;

If he is thirsty, give him a drink;

For in so doing you will heap coals of fire on his head.”

²¹ Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good.

Romans 12:1-21 (*these verses are a test between the spirit and the flesh)

¹² “Look, in this you are not righteous.

I will answer you,

For God is greater than man.

¹³ Why do you contend with Him?

For He does not give an accounting of any of His words.

¹⁴ For God may speak in one way, or in another,

Yet man does not perceive it.

¹⁵ In a dream, in a vision of the night,

When deep sleep falls upon men,

While slumbering on their beds,

¹⁶ Then He opens the ears of men,

And seals their instruction.

¹⁷ In order to turn man from his deed,

And conceal pride from man,

¹⁸ He keeps back his soul from the Pit,

God will give you the answer to all eight questions; lets start the year out right with this simple but powerful action step of faith!

D.) Are you battling confusion over these question?

(If no, arrange for a deliverance ministry time to remove the confusion.)

E.) Did you lack God's blessings in 2010?

Yes or No

(If yes, identify why in _____ amount of time and set a date for the answer.)

F.) Do you have peace about your past goals in 2010?

Yes or No

(If no, no written goals is the problem.)

G.) Do you have a prayer life and prayer partners?

Yes or No

(If no, adopt a pray life and a prayer partner that hears from God by _____.)

F.) Do you hear from God and does your prayer partners hear from God?

Yes or No

(If no, ask the Lord for one or both now He will bring you the answer.)

A true friend is not an enabler! A prayer partner must be able to confront disorder in His love.
