- 2.) Love
- 3.) Honor
- 4.) Unity

These four principles are your walls of protection.

Principle Number One: Faith. Faith is a belief and trust in God.

A.) <sup>17</sup> So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.  
Romans 10:17(NKJV)

B.) <sup>4</sup> “ Behold the proud,  
His soul is not upright in him;  
But the just shall live by his faith.  
Habakkuk 2:4 (NKJV)

C.) <sup>18</sup> to open their eyes, in order to turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan to God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins and an inheritance among those who are sanctified by faith in Me.’  
Acts 26:18 (NKJV)

Principle Number Two: Love. Love is a strong affection for God and His people.

A.) <sup>37</sup> Jesus said to him, “ ‘You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind.’  
Matthew 22:37 (NKJV)

B.) <sup>19</sup> ‘Honor your father and your mother,’ and, ‘You shall love your neighbor as yourself.’”  
Matthew 19:19 (NKJV)

C.) <sup>44</sup> But I say to you, love your enemies, bless those who curse you, do good to those who hate you, and pray for those who spitefully use you and persecute you,  
Matthew 5:44 (NKJV)

D.) <sup>12</sup> And because lawlessness will abound, the love of many will grow cold.  
Matthew 24:12 (NKJV)

E.) <sup>34</sup> A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another; as I have loved you, that you also love one another.  
John 13:34 (NKJV)

F.) <sup>6</sup> For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision nor uncircumcision avails anything, but faith working through love.  
Galatians 5:6 (NKJV)

G.) <sup>4</sup> Love suffers long and is kind; love does not envy; love does not parade itself, is not puffed up; <sup>5</sup> does not behave rudely, does not seek its own, is not provoked, thinks no evil; <sup>6</sup> does not rejoice in iniquity, but rejoices in the truth; <sup>7</sup> bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all

things. <sup>8</sup> Love never fails.  
1 Corinthians 13:4-8 (NKJV)

<sup>13</sup> And now abide faith, hope, love, these three; but the greatest of these is love.  
1 Corinthians 13:13 (NKJV)

The question: do you have faith in this God kind of love?  
If your answer is "yes," then the power of Godly honor and unity will destroy the destroyer of death for you!

Principle Number Three: Honor. In the natural, honor is recognized in outward respect. But in the spiritual realm honor positions you for supernatural victories.

A.) <sup>16</sup> ‘ Honor your father and your mother, as the LORD your God has commanded you, that your days may be long, and that it may be well with you in the land which the LORD your God is giving you.  
Deuteronomy 5:16 (NKJV)

B.) <sup>20</sup> But in a great house there are not only vessels of gold and silver, but also of wood and clay, some for honor and some for dishonor.  
2 Timothy 2:20 (NKJV)

C.) <sup>21</sup> Therefore if anyone cleanses himself from the latter, he will be a vessel for honor, sanctified and useful for the Master, prepared for every good work.  
2 Timothy 2:21(NKJV)

D.) <sup>17</sup> Honor all people. Love the brotherhood. Fear God. Honor the king.  
1 Peter 2:17 (NKJV)

Principle Number Four: Unity/Agreement. Unity is a mighty force!

A.) <sup>3</sup> Can two walk together, unless they are agreed?  
Amos 3:3 (NKJV)

B.) <sup>18</sup> “Assuredly, I say to you, whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven.<sup>19</sup> “Again I say to you that if two of you agree on earth concerning anything that they ask, it will be done for them by My Father in heaven.  
Matthew 18:18-19 (NKJV)

C.) <sup>1</sup> Behold, how good and how pleasant it is  
For brethren to dwell together in unity!

<sup>2</sup> It is like the precious oil upon the head,  
Running down on the beard,  
The beard of Aaron,  
Running down on the edge of his garments.

<sup>3</sup> It is like the dew of Hermon,  
Descending upon the mountains of Zion;  
For there the LORD commanded the blessing—  
Life forevermore.
