On this tour we will visit Ellis Island, Auschwitz, Israel and Petra—I have been waiting to take this trip for almost 20 years! Understanding the Holocaust and the depth of the hatred that the enemy has for Jewish people and Believers is incredibly important for Christians during this time. The harsh reality of the brutal manifestation of the satanic attack against the Jewish people during the 1940's cannot be explained with words but needs to be experienced by walking in their shoes. In 1991, on my first tour to Israel, I was walking along the boardwalk in Tel Aviv with a prophetic apostolic leader. During this walk the Holy Spirit was imparting to me the deep grief of the Lord and the horrors of the Holocaust during a time when the Church was relatively silent as the Jewish people experienced extreme need. I found myself alone on the beach with my eyes gazing out over the Mediterranean Sea and I cried out to the Lord, "not on my watch—make me a voice to bring this truth to light that this Holocaust might never happen again! Not on my watch!"

During this trip, October 1-12, 2010 we will travel, teach, and pray---we will be interceding and forgiving the sins of the nations. My friend, it will take a special type of Believer to answer this call for this once in a lifetime journey. The Not on My Watch Tour has been birthed with a heart to impart fresh oil and new wine and travailing tears that would come from God Himself for the equipping of all the five-fold ministry, that we might come into synergy with God's heart in this hour. Israel is the issue and the Jewish people are the target. The question burning in my heart at this time is, will we as the church stand with and cover the apple of His eye? In the most critical

hour of the earth will we be found doing these things unto the least of these His brethren (Matt 25:40)?
