



Prophetic Word for 2007 – 2008

2007 is going to be a rough year and 2008 will even be rougher. If you can't learn to walk and run with the foot soldiers, how will you run with the chariots? You need to let go and you need to let God. With what you have tonight and in the morning when you wake up, you need to be in a pattern of release. The Lord will never leave you nor forsake you if you return to Him every morning. For the Lord's mercies are new every morning and great, great is His faithfulness, and His compassion failith not.

2007 will be the greatest year of your life, if you let go and let God. If you do not let go and let God, it will be the worst year of your life. 2008 will make 2007 look like a bad year even though it's been the greatest year that you've ever had, because 2008 will be a full release of all provision for those who hang on and obey in 2007. The flood gates will be opened in 2008 in 3rd Day new beginnings. The test in the financial area will be those who sacrificially give in 2007 will be made millionaires and multi-millionaires in 2008. Those that operate cautiously in 2007 will be those who operate with their needs met but no extra in 2008. The purification that is coming in 2007 is the preparation for 2008 and for the Kingdom to come. If you submit to the process, 2007 is a bridge year in the Spirit. It is a year of a transfer not just of wealth, but spiritual power, spiritual dominion and spiritual authority. But clearly hear, "Fear not little flock what you see. Fear not little flock what you hear. For your God is well able to give you this kingdom. He is exceedingly, abundantly, well able to keep you in 2007 to promote you in 2008. Don't quit. Don't fear."

You'll feel like quitting and you may feel the fear. But remember the word that you got on the last night of Hanukkah, the Feast of Dedication. And say, "Oh no, I remember that night when I stood up in front of the great light that reflects my Messiah, Jesus. And I have a passport. I can pass through. I can do all things."

This year the Lord is unloading our carts so that we will not be spinning our wheels. There was a man that just started coming to the House Of David and he received a prophetic word from another prophet and he said that the Lord was going to make him like a Clydesdale. And he used to drive by this house when it was a home, and the owner used to have a huge Clydesdale, right out in the front. And that's actually part of the prophetic word for tonight. House of David is like a Clydesdale. It has the blinders. It pulls a heavy load. It's not a race horse. It's hooked to a team. It's not one Clydesdale, it's four or six. It's hauling the King of Kings, the Lord of Lords. The Lord is going to hook the House of David up by 2008 to six ministries. You understand we've been hooked recently to the Jewish National Fund that is definitely a

Clydesdale. Do you know their testimony is that they purchased the land of Israel? They hold Title Deed to the Land of Israel, the Jewish National Fund. And they are walking shoulder to shoulder, we are in covenant agreement. And I guarantee you the Jewish National Fund isn't looking off – “Well, I wonder what we're going to do over here.” - no, they're very much focused on the restoration of Israel. House of David – focused. We don't have to race, we just have to move with the other horses.

Now here is the end of the word – the problem with some of you is that you are called to the House of David but you're Western Ponies. You're used to being with one rider, you're used to a bit and you're used to spurs. In fact, if you don't like the way it's going, you just rare up or find a low branch and you knock the rider off and you go and move on to another church. Some of you need to transfer lordship and administration of your life over to the Holy Spirit. Some of you need to say I'm taking the western saddle, where I can only haul maybe a 150 – 200 lb man, and you need to dump the saddle; hook up with the rest of the Clydesdales; let the Lord put some good oats in you – some Word; come eat at the trough two days a week; make a commitment to put on some muscle, and let's haul the King. And it doesn't have to be your way. I don't know what any of you think but, technically, I guess I'm like CEO of this place, and I don't ever get my own way, never. We serve the congregation. Most congregants, I'm not even sure it that's a word, get their way more than I do, and supposedly I'm in control. I don't go usually when I want to go, and I don't get to say what I want to say. I got rid of the western saddle a long time ago. It's time for us to get the team of horses for what we're called to do, because we can't haul what God is asking us alone. God gets the glory when Jew and Gentile, Man and Woman, Old and Young, Black and White, First Nation and First Borne, what ever the combinations are, just like this beautiful setting right here, when we come together, God commands a blessing. Isn't that wonderful? So that's my word for all of you and I hope it's personal enough that you could receive it.

I spoke a word to a precious brother, about a year ago, similar to this and I told him he was going to have a tough year and to press in and it would be over and don't quit, and my heart's broke because he quit. And some of you will probably quit, but don't blame it on God. Because you heard all the Scriptures tonight that said, God will. So what you have to do is say, “Lord, Thy will not mine.” Say with me, “Lord it's not a feeling, it's a fact. You've made a covenant with me tonight, to finish it. It's sealed with Your blood. Even if I'm faithless, Your faithful. I will always return to You, even when I blow it. I receive grace to blow it. I pray I don't blow it, but when I do, I receive grace. In Jesus Name.”

Cut all that old religious lie off, “Oh, now I've sinned, I've done this and I can't...” and you put yourself in purgatory. “Well I'm going to be over here in the Penalty Box because I did this.” God didn't put you in the Penalty Box; you're a repentance away from restarting. Don't let the enemy put on depression and don't dwell on the sin and don't dwell on Satan, dwell on the goodness of God. Magnify God, not the sin. I've got news for you, you're going to sin. You're in a process. And for those who sin around you, hate the sin, love the sinner.
