We're here at the amphitheater, and standing here I feel like the Apostle Paul, bringing the Word with fire to our partners. We want to thank you for your monthly support to be able to send us to the land of Israel, to bring support and help and humanitarian aid. You're going to see some wonderful clips here. You're going to see at the Gloani school, a special needs school, where the principal is blind, literally, but has insight from his heart to lead these children, over 100 children with special needs. He takes care of them every day. House of David is going to be a part of it. We want to build two buildings for them, and have an expansion for four classrooms. They have all sorts of other needs that you'll get in our newsletter. I am so excited for Stan and Audrey Crawford. We are so excited for these dentists to be able to get their dream to come true...their own dental clinic right her in Beit Shean, Israel. We need your monthly support for this. We need you to call your dentist that you know that has a heart to be able to go to Israel and help work and come along side us. We want to keep this clinic open at least four days a week, meeting the needs of the children here in Beit Shean, and surrounding areas. Also you will see about exciting programs where we are sending adult diapers to Hadassah Hospital, where for \$5,000 you can send one 40-foot container with a hundred-thousand diapers on it. You can bring dignity back to these holocaust survivors, and many of these elderly people, as they can go and visit their families without worry about shame, because these diapers literally give them a liberty to be able to leave this hospital and this nursing facility, especially now with the fall feasts of Rosh Hashana and the Feast of Tabernacles. Let them join their family! Your gift makes a way for them to be part of that. We are so excited about the food program that is going to start in Beit Shean. We talked with the Mayor here, Jackie Levy. Jackie Levy's not just the Mayor, but he's a shepherd after his people, and he wants us, you and I, House of David partners to be able to adopt families here in Beit Shean, to bring special meals for all the feasts of Israel. We have Rosh Hashana and the Feast of Trumpets coming, would you please email me and say "My prayer group, my church, my organization wants to be able to bring a meal in to these needy families and do it with dignity. I want to be a part of it!" You need to be able to call, you need to be able to email us and let us know what's moving on your heart today. This is the most exciting time to be alive, as these doors open! House of David has just received their own amuta, which means we are a non-profit organization in Israel. So we are going to be able to more and more, and the name that they elected for us to be able to have as a legal name in Israel is House of David, Friends of Israel. You are t a friend of Israel!
